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Biographies

ALEXANDRE BAVARD

Born in 1987, Paris

Bavard, committed and multidisciplinary work reflects social, ecological and urban realities. A product of the graffiti culture, his projects can be seen as the result of years of exploring territories and penetrating a present that is bound to change.

LIEN BOTHA

Born in 1961, Gauteng

Lien Botha experiments with the photographic medium beyond its documentary framework, through enigmatic images deconstructing reality and place. Botha creates a private inventory in which her images/objects do not easily reveal their place in a specific narrative. Rather they seem to act as an index or even co-ordinates of her travels across the country that give a sense of her bearings, rather than fix location.

ANTOINE CARBONNE

Born in 1987, Paris

Antoine Carbonne's work is above all a construction of the mind. Operating a phenomenon of back and forth between real forms and fantasized elements, he delivers to the viewer images where the daily life of contemporary society is at the heart of his reflection.

BENJAMIN DÉGUÉNON

Born in 1985, Mono

Mystical anthropomorphic creatures of Déguénon explore themes such as the self, cultural memory and myths, and the distorted body. Drawing on the rich traditions of his Beninese heritage, Déguénon uses a color palette filled with electric blue dotted with red to create fanciful worlds where stories take place.

DELPHINE DÉNÉRÉAZ

Born in 1989, Vaison-la-Romaine

Inspired by contemporary aesthetics and with a real interest in carpets, a symbolic object of Mediterranean culture, Delphine Dénéréaz transforms domestic fabrics that she recovers (sheets, tablecloths, curtains) into tapestries.

ANGÈLE ESSAMBA

Born in 1962, Douala

Essamba talks about visual communication beyond words, with gestures, looks. More than magnifying and exalting, her photography celebrates the human being, captured as it is, in its singularity and universality. Her power of visual imagery and aesthetics fascinate as much as symbolism questions.

SAFIA HIJOS

Born in 1975, Castres

After studying law and then several years in legal practice, she decided to devote herself to ceramics. Today, this ceramicist works in her own studio, exhibits across Europe and further afield on a regular basis, and teaches from time to time in various institutions.

FABIENNE GUILBERT BURGOA

Born in 1992, Mexico

Fabienne Guilbert Burgoa plays with everyday objects and redefines the notion of utility. Through an absolute need to make the useful useless and the useless essential to individual rituals. The artist enjoys ricocheting off the codes of practices and languages. Guilbert likes to erase the barriers between design, craftsmanship and contemporary art, between innovative forms and traditional know-how.

AMANDINE GURUCEAGA

Born in 1989, Toulouse

Amandine Guruceaga' chooses specific materials (textiles, metals, leathers) which she will transform according to different gestures and tools: dye, discolor, engrave, cut, pinch, unfold, melt, burn, oxidize, stack, dissolve. She works with the material to go beyond its limits and obtain astonishing optical translations where the translucent leather becomes textile, the bleached textile becomes stained glass, oxidized metal becomes watercolor.

MARIO MACILAU

Born in 1984, Maputo

Mário Macilau was working in the markets of Mozambique when he bought a camera at the age of 14. In his works, he deploys a powerful visual language and strong aesthetic biases which he puts at the service of a committed discourse. With the portrait as a starting point and seeking above all to reveal the strength of traditions and transmission, the artist offers us contrasting monochromes where different perceptions of the supernatural intersect.

MAISHA MARSHALL-ENDE

Born in 1990, Addis Ababa

The Ethiopian-Canadian artist brings together past and present in her pieces that reimagines the classic Ethiopian references (like mattress print). She sets out to reconcile the complexities of culture and Blackness through her practice. Her bodies of work range from commercially based editorials, often commenting on and deconstructing the notions of how the photograph is usually seen and the preciousness connected to the world of fine art photography.

LUAM MELAKE

Born in 1986, San Diego

Melake refers to the histories and methodologies of art, design, craft, architecture, and industrial manufacturing, often borrowing techniques and materials from each of these fields, to create one-of-a-kind works. Her furniture design and mixed-media textile works reveal a delicate combination of counterintuitive materials and unorthodox structures. The resulting works reveals a certain tension between the handmade art object and the industrially produced product.

KIRUBEL MELKE

Born in 1983, Addis Ababa

Inspired by his mother's employment in a textile factory, Melke's artwork predominantly revolves around the use of fabric as a symbol of everyday life. He transforms and elevates these everyday materials into thought-provoking works of art that explore education, social injustice, and the relationship between tradition and modernity. Through his work, he highlights "pressing" issues related to contemporary Ethiopian culture.

ZIAD NAITADDI

Born in 1995, Rabat

Ziad Naitaddi is a self-taught artist.

Through a cinematographic approach to narration, since 2013 he has explored, in the form of documentary and fiction, different subjects ranging from identity, migration and even landscapes.

OTHMANE OUALLAL

Born in 1996, Tazarine

Ouallal is part of a process of research and creation, both plastic and visual, around collective memory and local heritage, notably the heritage of his native village, the oasis of Tazarine. His artistic practice and aesthetic vision are particularly influenced by cultural anthropology, ecology and archives.

LEONARD RACHEX

Born in 1990, Bonneville

Léonard Rachex artistic approach attempts to complicate the figure of the artist and the notion of author. Using humor and the absurd as a tool, Léonard Rachex's work is often an excuse for dialogue, encounters, fiction and play.

ANNA RINZO

Born in 1995, Paris

Rinzo uses hand weaving to create works mixing diverse textile materials gleaned from her family and close circle, and various plants and fibers that she collected and studied during her travels. Her work develops around cellular memory and epigenetics.

MEKBIB TADESSE

Born in 1990, Addis Ababa

Using the practice of the photographic studio, Mekbib Tadesse questions the interpersonal and institutional relationships of the contemporary societal fabric. In his portraiture practice, Tadesse uses photography as a storytelling medium.

YONATAN WONDWOSEN

Born in 1988, Addis Ababa

Yonatan Wondwosen uses meticulous collage and painting techniques on paper or canvas to create precise and detailed works. The artist seeks to record and commemorate the present that provides a glimpse into the future. To give form to unknown or invisible things.

Often these things are emotions and thoughts of man, either in the present state or those which cause growth or change. Behind his big doors painting, he imagines all kinds of activities giving him the feeling that they are orchestrated to create a musicality.

CHARLOTTE YONGA

Born in 1985, Paris

Charlotte Yonga takes a close look at individuals and territories. Her photographic approach, imbued with dramaturgy, inherits a certain documentary tradition and is crossed by questions related to the notion of individuality subject to relocation, to the dynamics of otherness and to personal identity processes. The subjects she represents, most of the time 'ordinary' people captured in characteristic contexts, are at the center of attention and face the viewer. In an alchemy that calls together with realism, strength and fragility, Charlotte erects tangible bodies and personalities captured in their complexities.
